21st Annual Meeting American Academy of Veterinary Acupuncture

We are pleased to invite credentialed veterinarians to submit abstracts of a presentation for our 2026 meeting. Submission of a paper represents a commitment to present this paper for the on-demand meeting if it is selected. Papers selected will be presented by the Author and printed in the 2026 Proceedings Book of the event.

Topics covering acupuncture and Traditional Eastern Medicine related therapies will be considered. Case studies or in-depth discussions on specific Eastern Medicine techniques will also be considered.

Abstracts must be typewritten in English, double-spaced and should not exceed a single page of 8.5" x 11" paper (A4) with 1" margins (2.5 cm). Please format the abstract in a Microsoft Word document and send it as an attached document identified as "2026 AAVA ABSTRACT" in the email subject line.

Curriculum Vitae for each author must accompany the abstract. Abstracts submitted without this information will not be considered.

The deadline for submission is August 15, 2025.

Notification of acceptance will be sent by October 2, 2025, to those whose abstracts are selected by the AAVA Conference Committee for presentation at the meeting. The deadline for submission of the full article for the Proceedings Book will be January 13, 2026.

Speakers will receive honoraria of \$250 per speaking hour and receive a complimentary conference registration.
